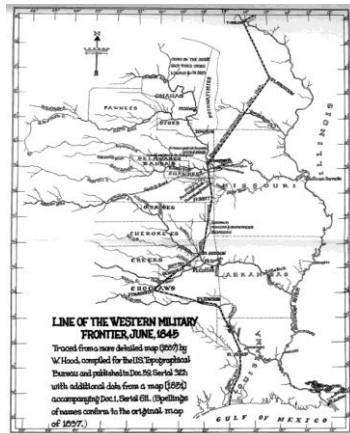

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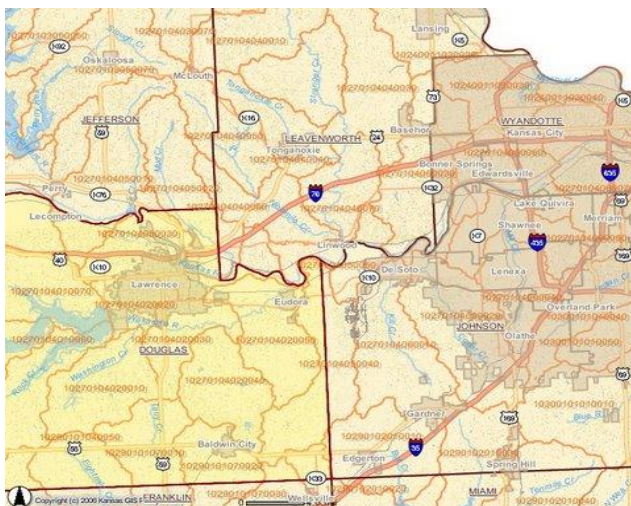
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**[OCTA-Trails]** The principal routes in the Kansas City Area were Westport and Independence. Additional routes were the California road, which went from Westport to Lawrence. It connected with Fort Leavenworth and Fort Scott via the Frontier Military Road. The Frontier Army built this route instead of it being cut from the earth by wagon trains.
